

Shared paths for cyclists and pedestrians

OVERVIEW

The **Gateway WA Perth Airport and Freight Access Project** is WA's largest ever road project, designed to improve the safety and efficiency of one of the state's most important transport hubs.

The project will deliver a number of upgraded and improved facilities, designed to enhance the local area both in function and aesthetics. Among these facilities is a Principal Shared Path network.

The Gateway WA project is jointly funded by the Australian (\$676 million) and State (\$310 million) Governments.

DESCRIPTION

Cycling infrastructure is an important part of major transport projects such as Gateway WA.

Perth has experienced an increase in the number of cyclists using paths in recent years for commuting purposes, exercise and leisure. This leads to fewer cars on the roads and improved traffic flow.

The project is installing about 21 kilometres of Principal Shared Path and local connections next to the new road alignment along Tonkin and Leach Highways, the extension of Leach Highway into Perth Airport (Airport Drive), and Roe Highway.

Seven cyclist/pedestrian underpasses and one bridge have been constructed to provide connectivity for the network with lighting installed along the way to increase visibility for users.

BENEFITS

- It is a safe way for the public to cycle or walk separated from a busy road network.
- There are multiple local connections where people can join the pathway.
- The network provides opportunities for people to walk and cycle for health and recreational purposes or to commute to their workplaces.

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TIMELINE FOR DELIVERY

The Principal Shared Path network will be open to the public in line with the overall project completion in 2016.

Parts of the network will be progressively opened to cyclists and pedestrians.

Cyclists and pedestrians are reminded to take care when sharing the path with others.

Redcliffe	Victoria Street, Stanton Road, Redcliffe Park / Dayana Court and Klem Avenue
Cloverdale	Epsom Avenue / Middleton Park, Middleton Street, Hardey Road, Guilfoyle Green / Whiteside Road, Belgravia Street, Glassford Road, Fisher Street, Tighe Street, Abernethy Road, Robinson Avenue and Treave Street
Kewdale	Belmont Avenue, Knutsford Avenue, Acton Avenue, Jeffrey Street, Tipping Road, Cassella Place and Daddow Road
Forrestfield	Hardey East Road, Quartz Lane / Calcite Place, Marble Place, Limonite Court, Pumice Court, Reynolds Road, Pavetta Crescent and Berkshire Road
